TITLE: Assistant Football Coach

DUTIES: This position is for the fall 2018 boys' football season. This assistant coach is needed due to the need for safety and support for the boys turning out for football season. The assistant coach is expected to assist the head coach and work with him as said coach deems necessary. Primarily, the assistant coach will be able to help with the various positions as assigned by the head coach. Football practices run from late August through the end of the season, approximately October 25th. The assistant coach is expected to make all practices and games, ride the bus to and from all games requiring bus transportation, and maintain acceptable discipline from all players. The assistant coach is expected to handle other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum requirements include successful coaching of team sports and general knowledge of football rules, strategies, techniques and safety concerns. Applicants must possess current first aid card or be able to obtain one prior to start of season. They will need to complete an online training for Sudden Cardiac Arrest and Concussion Management training upon hire. This position requires organizational skills, empathy, adaptability, a positive attitude, good work ethic, and the ability to motivate and discipline.

SALARY AND BENEFITS: \$1,000 for the season.
