Working in conjunction with special education teachers, this person works one-on-one with students in a remote setting delivering education services according to the students IEP in reading, writing or mathematics.

The newly-hired para educator reports to work each day at the CVA offices on the Valley campus. In addition to daily work contact, all staff connect with each other and their administration through regular staff meetings, and professional development opportunities. This position reports to the CVA Principal or Assistant Principal.
