## District Election

### Purpose

This policy establishes the criteria and timing for qualification as a School Board candidate.

### Scope

This policy applies to voting citizens of Valley School District No. 070 who may be interested in declaring candidacy for a position on the Board of Directors.

### Policy

A school board election shall be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November of the odd numbered years.

A person may become a candidate for a place on the Board by filing a declaration of candidacy with the County Auditor during the July filing period as prescribed by law. In the event that there are more than two candidates for any position on the Board, a primary election shall be held on the third Tuesday of September in the manner prescribed by law. The two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes will appear on the school election ballot the following November.

A person is legally qualified to become a member of the Board who is a United States citizen and a qualified voter of the school district. Employees of the school district are precluded from serving on the Board of Directors by RCW 42.23.030
