
Student Learning Committee

Purpose

This policy provides for the establishment and purpose of the Student Learning Committee.

Scope

This policy is directed to the Superintendent and involves the Board of Directors and the Principal.

Policy

1. Among the duties vested in our School Board of Directors is one of curriculum development and program accountability. The Board of Directors believes that the best way to insure the best possible curriculum development and procedures for accountability is to involve those persons that are directly involved or are concerned with the teaching and learning process. Those persons are teachers, teacher assistants, community members, parents, and the principal.
2. The Board of Directors, therefore, directs the Superintendent to form a student learning committee consisting of representatives of the above groups with the following duties:
 - (a) Complete a school-based application for a state student learning improvement grant.
 - (b) Develop a long-range district school improvement plan (5 year).
 - (c) Develop a time line to accomplish the plan.
 - (d) Identify the resources and training necessary to complete the plan.
 - (e) Monitor and revise the plan as necessary to ensure progress toward completion.
3. The committee shall be chaired by the building principal and submit their recommendations to the Board of Directors for approval.
