
Readmission Provisions – Expulsion/Suspension

Purpose

This policy defines how a student previously suspended may apply for re-admittance.

Scope

This policy applies to the Superintendent, Principal, parents, students and Valley School District staff personnel.

Policy

Any pupil who has been expelled or suspended shall be permitted to apply for re-admittance to the district schools prior to the termination of the imposed sanction. The application shall be in writing and sent to the principal of the school which the student would ordinarily attend. The principal may establish readmission conditions which are related to the student's prior record of behavior. If the application is denied, the student or parent may appeal to the Superintendent. Whose decision shall be final.
