

Student Health

Purpose

This policy sets forth provisions for student health care and nursing services, supporting required health screenings, immunization program, and student care plans and recordkeeping.

Scope

This policy applies to the Superintendent, administrators, staff, school nurse, students, parents or guardians, and public healthcare providers and agencies.

Policy

1. The Superintendent will arrange for health services to be provided to all students. Such services will include, but not be limited to:
 - (a) The maintenance of student health records.
 - (b) The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill during the school day.
 - (c) Consulting services of a qualified health specialist.
 - (d) Vision and hearing screening.
 - (e) Immunization records and screening.
