## **Response to Student Injury or Illness**

### **Purpose**

This policy sets forth the parameters for staff response to emergency student injury or illness.

### **Scope**

This policy applies to the Superintendent, school administrators, staff, students, and parents or guardians.

### **Policy**

1. The Board recognizes that schools are responsible for providing first aid or emergency treatment in case of injury or illness of a student. To that end, the Board encourages school staff to become certified in first aid. Further medical attention in non-emergency cases is the responsibility of the parents or guardian.
2. School staff will notify the parents or guardians of students who suffer injuries, illness or physical trauma at school or at any school-sponsored activity as soon as practicable.
3. The Superintendent or designee will establish procedures to be followed consistent with this policy.
