

# WIN Time

Valley School provides quality support programs through the federal Title I and state Learning Assistance Program (LAP). Our intervention program is called **WIN (What I Need) Time**. **WIN Time** is scheduled into the day so that students don't miss core instruction.

All students at Valley School receive services according to their individual needs. Qualifications for these support services are based upon several standardized and benchmarked assessments. There are three levels of service:

- Students who qualify for level 1 services receive enrichment from their classroom teacher.
- Students who qualify for level 2 services receive additional strategic interventions from their classroom teacher and/or from a Title I or LAP specialist/instructional assistant.
- Students who qualify for level 3 services receive intensive intervention instruction from a Title I or LAP specialist/instructional assistant based on available staffing.

The model that Valley School has chosen to use provides these support services in a combination of ways (in-class center activities, special groupings, or one-on-one pull-out instruction) that keeps students in the classroom for core instruction.
